**T-Mobile has made application to build a 120-foot-high cell tower immediately adjacent to the Hamilton Cemetery on the property of the Neptune Door Company. This is what it will look like.**

The Old Corlies Avenue Preservation Alliance (OCAPA) is opposed to it since it will:

- Defile this historic and present day cemetery
- Diminish its attractiveness for use as a cemetery and, thereby, its financial status
- Defile a lengthy section of historic and residential Old Corlies Avenue including the Hamilton Methodist Church
- Diminish neighboring property values.

Furthermore, hundreds of people who own grave spaces in the cemetery and have special interest in its surroundings **will not** be notified of this application and, therefore, **will not** have an opportunity to comment on it. We are of the strong opinion that most of these people would agree with OCAPA on this matter.
